TAMPA – Deborah Cox-Roush, Chairman of the Hillsborough County Republican Party, announced today that federal, state, and local Republican candidates will introduce themselves at the Republican Executive Committee meeting on May 19th at the Blaise Alfano Convention and Conference Center in Tampa.
